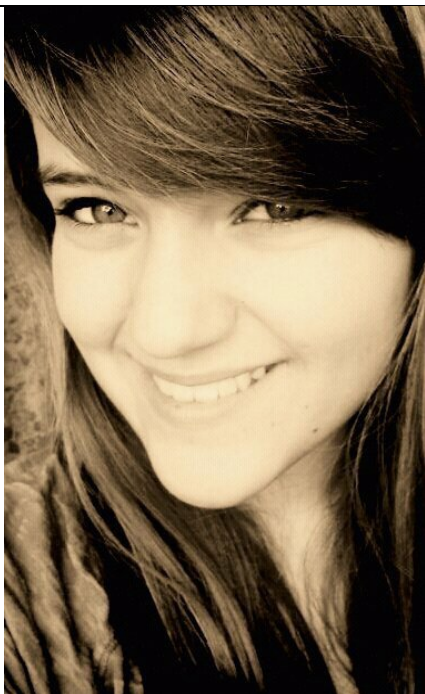


Sidney Marie Joines
